Bill Ashcroft is an Emeritus Professor in the School of English, Media and Performing Arts at the University of New South Wales, Sydney. He is a founding exponent of postcolonial theory, co-author of *The Empire Writes Back*, the first text to examine systematically the field of postcolonial studies, as well as of *Key Concepts in Post-Colonial Studies*. He is author and co-author of twenty-one books, variously translated into five languages, including *Post-Colonial Transformation* (Routledge 2001), *Post-Colonial Futures* (Continuum 2001); *Caliban's Voice* (Routledge 2008) *Intimate Horizons* (ATF 2009) and *Utopianism in Postcolonial Literatures* (Routledge 2016). He is the author of over 200 chapters and papers, and he is on the editorial boards of ten international journals.
